

Pakenham Hills PS Child Safety Risk Management Strategies

At Pakenham Hills Primary School our child safety risk management strategy is a formal and structured approach to managing risks associated with child safety. Our school Child Safe Policy and Code of Conduct clearly outline our commitment to implementing the standards for child safety as outlined in the Ministerial Order No. 870.

At Pakenham Hills Primary School our process includes risk assessment (see matrix below), implementation of controls and a monitoring and review process to ensure the currency of the risk management approach.
