

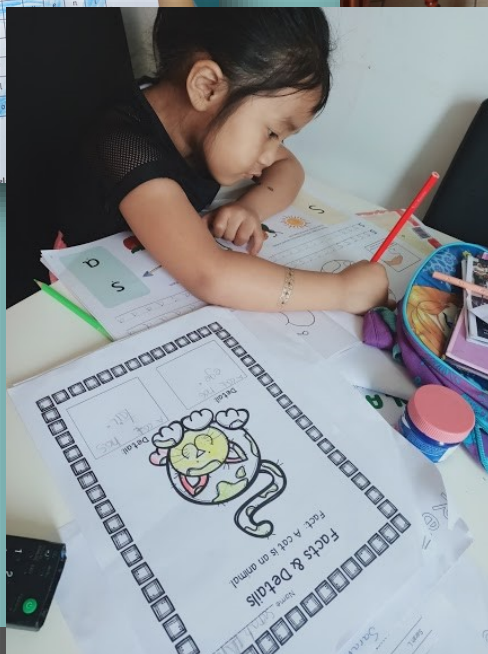
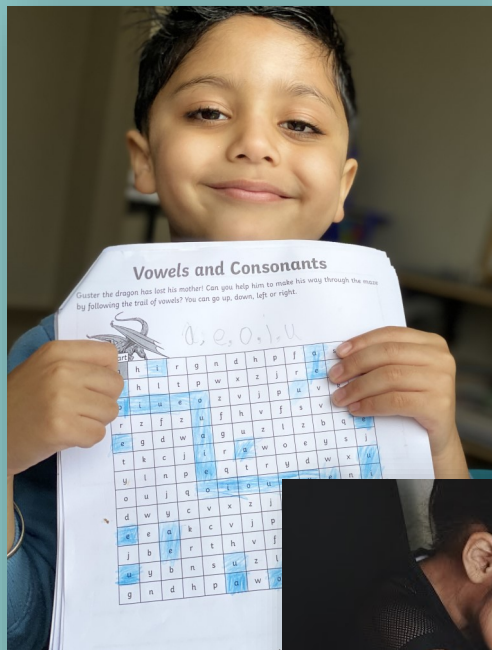

# Principal's Post

## Welcome!

I would like to thank the parents for their support as we have moved back to remote learning.

We would also like to thank parents for their continued feedback.

As announced by the Premier, as from Thursday 23rd July, face masks must be worn by everybody over 12 years old whenever they leave their house.

As a result all staff and parents who come to the school must be wearing a mask. Students can wear a mask but they are not compulsory. All students and staff will be expected to provide their own face masks.

Teachers are exempt from wearing a mask if they are teaching, however they can wear one if they want to when on the school site.

We have a group of staff on site each day

supporting the students who attend on site.

These staff may be wearing a mask when they instruct students (they will be wearing a mask at all other times).

We have a Level Team on site each day, supervising classes in rooms 9, 10, 11 and 12.

These staff may be wearing a mask when they are online with your children. All other teachers are working online from home. These staff will not be wearing a mask.

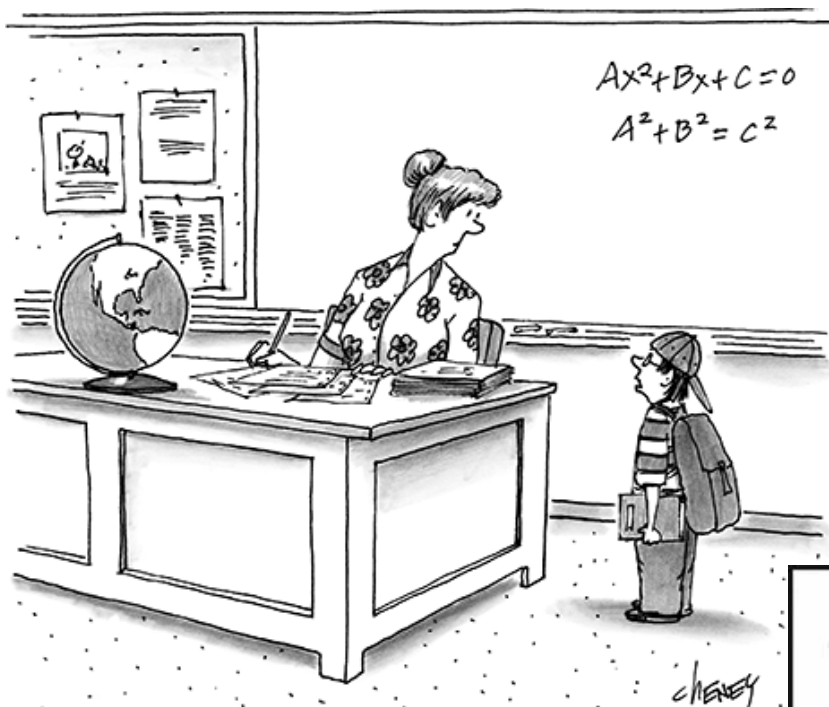

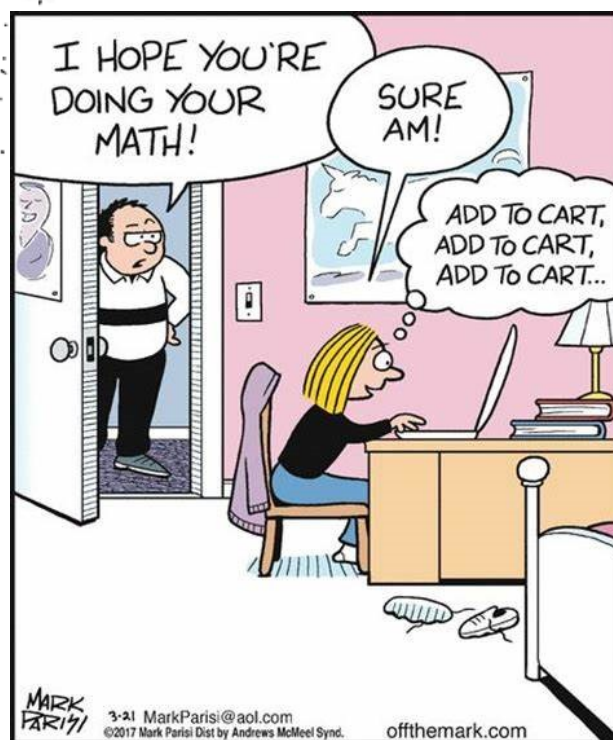
