# Principal's Post



## Welcome

### School Concert

School Concert is scheduled for **Wednesday 31st August and Thursday 1st September**. This year concert will be being done as an afternoon matinee at the Cardinia Cultural Centre. Students will attend the Cultural Centre in the morning for rehearsal and then performances will be in the afternoon. Students will go home with parents at the end of the concert. A professional video of the concert will be made and be available to parents for a small cost.

### Pupil Free Day

As part the new Education EBA teachers are entitled to "Professional Planning Days" (PPD). The second of these will be being held on **Friday 2nd September**. This is a pupil Free day and students will not be at school on this day.

### Enterprise Bargaining Agreement (EBA)

On the 25<sup>th</sup> July, the latest EBA that covers teachers and schools came into effect. This EBA has implemented time-in-lieu for teachers for the first time. Historically, teachers have always volunteered their time for camps and activities that are out of work hours. With this new agreement, they are now entitled to be paid for this extra time. Having agreed to put this clause into the agreement, the government has also said it will not pay for this time-in-lieu and school's will need to find the money themselves. This provides a significant dilemma for schools in regards to

finding the money to cover time-in-lieu.

To give an example of the cost involved, I will use the upcoming year 5 & 6 camp. The cost of the camp is \$290. There are 9 teaching staff attending camp. Each teacher will be entitled to a mix of 100% time-in-lieu for time on-duty after school hours, from 4.30pm–10.30pm. They are then entitled to 50% time-in-lieu after that as they are on call until the students wake up in the morning. They are then on-duty from the time the first few students are awake and out of bed until 8.30am, when the paid for day starts. The accumulated time-in-lieu hours equates to three days of time-in-lieu for each staff member.

The cost works out at time-in-lieu hours X CRT (Casual Relief Teacher) cost (\$510.40 per day) X 9. For this camp alone that works out to \$13,800. If we were to charge parents for this, it would add \$153.00 to the cost of camp for each child. The agreement also stipulates that teachers take their time-in-lieu in the fortnight following the activity where it was accumulated.

Like many school's across the state we are going to have to re-think how we do a range of activities as a school and how many of these can now be done within the working day between 8:45am and 4:45pm.

## Make Every Day Count

**Attending all day, every day helps students to build their learning and maintain strong social connections with their friends and teachers. Each lesson provides a foundation for the next one, making it easier to learn the next concept.**

At Pakenham Hills Primary School we encourage all students to attend school each day and most importantly arrive on time. Teachers and students have the chance to chat and settle in for a day of learning. Students are able to follow their 'Getting ready to Learn' routines and participate in Circle Time. This is an important time to build relationships, make friends and have fun.

### What impact does being late have on the student?

Students who are late miss a lot of instructions and information about what is happening, not to mention important learning situations. This means that they have to catch up somehow. It's like being late to see a movie and not being able to understand what's happening because you don't know who the characters are and what the plot is.

Students can feel unsettled, disorganized and unhappy for the rest of the day and it can take them some time to complete and understand the work that they have missed.

If your child arrives after the 9:00am bell they will be marked as late and this will require you to provide a reason for the late arrival. ## School Concert 2022

I am pleased to inform you that we are well underway in our preparations for our 2022 school concert “**In Your Dreams**” which will be held at the **Cardinia Cultural Centre** in Pakenham. Students have had the opportunity to contribute ideas for story line, characters, dialogue, class items, songs and choreography and are now learning their performance pieces.



It is important to bring to your attention that the structure of our concert has changed this year. Due to the new teacher agreement, we can no longer present our show as an evening performance. **Our show will now be presented as a matinée at 2:30pm** (doors open at 2:15pm for seating). We understand that this may cause inconvenience for some families but this change is unavoidable. Our show will also be recorded, for purchase, by a professional videographer to ensure the best possible quality.

On their performance day, students will travel via bus to the Cardinia Cultural Centre. They will spend the morning rehearsing on stage with any props and sets to prepare for their performance that afternoon.
